The petitioners seek grant of regular bail in case FIR No.26,
dated 23.4.2015, registered under Section 21 of the NDPS Act, at Police
Station Khemkaran, District Tarn Taran.

Counsel for the petitioners has argued that the petitioners
have been in custody for the last 1½ year and there is no evidence against
them except the disclosure statement of the co-accused.

On the last date, the following order was passed :-

“ Learned Deputy Advocate General on instructions from the Investigating Officer states that the remaining witnesses will be examined on or before 31.01.2017 and till such time the bail should not be granted to the petitioners.

Adjourned to 25.10.2016. In the meantime, the Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran is directed to file affidavit with regard to the aforesaid undertaking.”

Today, affidavit of Manmohan Kumar, SSP, Tarn Taran has been filed, as per which it has been undertaken that the prosecution will conclude its entire evidence on or before 31.1.2017 subject to the accused not obstructing the same.

Consequently, this petition is dismissed but the trial Court is directed to release the petitioners on bail in case the prosecution does not conclude its entire evidence on or before 31.1.2017 subject to the accused not obstructing the same.
