The petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in case FIR No.93, dated 28.7.2014, registered under Sections 22, 21, 29 of the NDPS Act and Section 473 of the IPC, at Police Station Sarai Amanat Khan, District Amritsar City.

Counsel for the petitioner has argued that the petitioner at best can be found guilty under Section 29 of the NDPS Act since no recovery was effected from him. The trial is nowhere near conclusion.

Counsel for the respondent, on instructions from ASI Balbir

Singh, has accepted these factual assertions.

In these circumstances, without commenting upon the merits of the case, and keeping in view the period of custody already suffered by the petitioner, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Petition stands disposed of.
