Petitioners claim that they have attained majority and have married against the wishes of their family members. Apprehending threat to their life and liberty, they have approached this Court for protection.

Notice to the respondents.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Ramesh Kumar, AAG, Haryana, present in the Court, accepts notice. Copy given.

Mr. Namit Khurana, Advocate, has put in appearance on behalf of respondent of respondents No. 4 and 5, parents of petitioner No.1, to submit that there is no threat to the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of said respondents.

It appears that the relationship of the petitioners has been accepted by the parents of petitioner No.1.

The petitioners appear to have filed a representation to Superintendent of Police, Hisar, copy of which has been appended as Annexure P-4.

The matter is covered by the judgment of this Court in **Pradeep Kumar Vs. State of Haryana, 2008 (3) RCR (Criminal) 376.**

This petition is disposed of with a direction that the petitioners will not be forcibly taken in custody by any of the respondents on the allegations that petitioner No.1 has been kidnapped or abducted by petitioner No.2. It is further ordered that in case of any imminent threat to the petitioners, it will be open to them to approach the Superintendent of Police, Hisar for appropriate protection who would ensure the implementation of order passed by this Court.
