JASPAL SINGH, J.(ORAL)

By virtue of the instant petition preferred under Section 438 of Code of Criminal Procedure, petitioner has sought directions to respondent No.2 to release him on bail in the even of his arrest in case bearing FIR No.86 dated 01.05.2013, under Sections 420/120-B, registered at Police Station Division No.5, Ludhaina.

At the very outset of the arguments, it has emerged that parties have effected the compromise and have amicably settled their dispute. The said compromise has already been reduced into writing. The copy of which is Annexure P-4. Moreover, Mr. Sumeet S. Brar, Advocate who is representing the complainant has admitted the factum of the compromise as well as final settlement arrived at between the parties. He has further stated that he has no objection, in case, the relief claimed by the petitioner is granted.

In view of the fact that parties have effected the compromise, petition is allowed and petitioner is ordered to be released on bail. However, subject to the conditions that the petitioner is directed to join the investigation as and when required by the Police.
