This is a petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for issuance of directions to respondents No. 1 to 4 to protect the lives and liberty of the petitioners from the hands of respondents No. 5 to 10 as they have solemnized marriage against the wishes and consent of respondents No.5 to 10.

2. The petitioners moved representation (Annexure P-5) to respondents No. 1 to 3, for getting the needful done but no action has been taken so far.

3. Notice to respondents No.1 to 4, only at this stage.

4. At the asking of Court, Mr. Rajpreet Singh Sidhu, AAG,

Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State of Punjab.
Copy of the petition be supplied to learned State counsel during the course of day.

5. The present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 - Senior Superintendent of Police, Batala, District Batala and respondent No.3 – Senior Superintendent of Police, Gurdaspur, District Gurdaspur to look into the grievances of the petitioners unfolded by them in their representation dated January 27, 2016 (Annexure P-5) and if found necessary, take appropriate measures in accordance with law.

6. However, this order shall not be construed as a measure to treat the marriage of the petitioners valid or legal.
