By virtue of instant petition preferred under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, Sultan Singh-petitioner has sought issuance of direction to respondents No. 1 to 4 to get an independent inquiry conducted with regard to the false implication of the petitioner in case bearing FIR No. 42, dated 11.09.2016, under Section 22 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 (for short, "Act"), Police Station Sadar Budhlada, District Mansa.

2. Notice of motion to respondents-State only, at this stage.
3. On the asking of Court, Mr. RPS Sidhu, AAG, Punjab has accepted notice on behalf of respondent-State. Copy of the petition be supplied to learned State counsel during the course of the day.
4. During the Course of arguments, it has been submitted by learned

counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner approached respondent No.4-Senior Superintendent of Police, Mansa, unfolding all the allegations mentioned in the instant petition but he refused to take any action by simply saying that respondent No.5 is posted as SHO. However, no detailed representation has been moved by the petitioner either to the SSP or to any other senior police officials.

5. The instant petition is disposed of with the direction to the petitioner to move a detailed representation/complaint, unfolding all the allegations, to Inspector General of Police, Bathinda within a period of 7 days from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order and as and when representation/complaint is received in his office, to inquire into the matter and if some substance is found in the allegations, to take appropriate action in accordance with law within a period of two months from the date of receipt of representation/complaint.
