This is second application for the grant of pre-arrest bail on the basis of compromise.

Counsel for the complainant has submitted that no doubt the matter was compromised but it was subject to payment of money by the petitioners as per the agreement dated 22.7.2016. He has made available copy of the original agreement containing the terms of the compromise which have been concealed by the petitioners. It is taken on record.

Counsel for the complainant further submits that the matter will be deemed to have been compromised only when the terms of the compromise dated 22.7.2016 are adhered to in letter and spirit.

I have considered the facts and circumstances of the case. The second petition is not maintainable as the terms of the compromise have not been implemented.

The petition is dismissed without prejudice to the right of the petitioners to approach this Court again after the terms of the compromise are complied with in letter and spirit.
