The petitioner is scribe of a Will which is alleged to be forged in connivance with the other co-accused. The FIR was registered at the instance of Ajay Pal Singh alleging that while the complainant along with his wife has been residing abroad, Surjit Singh on the basis of Will, has got mutation entered. In the present case, the property belonging to Wazir Singh came to the share of Kamaljit Kaur wife of the complainant. The mutation of inheritance was got entered on the basis of forged Will of Kamaljit Kaur by Surjit Singh.

It has been informed that the revenue record has now been rectified.

Be that as it may, the petitioner has been in custody w.e.f. 17.08.2016. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody.

The petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Duty Magistrate/Chief Judicial Magistrate, Ludhiana.
