The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.549 dated 27.12.2015, registered under Sections 363, 366-A, 506 IPC and Section 6 of POCSO Act, Police Station Sadar Panipat, District Panipat.

Counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is in custody since 01.01.2016 and only 03 witnesses have been examined.

A missing report was lodged by the father. The girl was stated to be around 16 years of age. The FIR was lodged after four days of the incident. The complainant and the victim have been examined. The prosecutrix had not supported the prosecution version.

The trial would take time to conclude. Without commenting upon the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail on execution of adequate personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
