After arguing for some time, the learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the instant petition but liberty may be granted to the petitioner to surrender before the Competent Court and move an application for grant of regular bail and a direction may be issued to the Court to decide the said application expeditiously.

Accordingly, the instant petition stands dismissed as not pressed. In case, the petitioner surrenders before the Competent Court on or before 03.10.2016 and moves an application for grant of regular bail, the same shall be decided expeditiously by the learned trial Court but in any case on or before 06.10.2016.
