Heard learned Counsel for the rival parties. The petitioners seek quashing of FIR No.29 dated 5.3.2016, under Sections 307, 323, 506, 120-B, 148, 149 IPC, PS Talwandi Sabo, District Bathinda on the basis of compounding/compromise. Pursuant to the order dated 20.9.2016, report of the learned Sessions Judge, Bathinda has been received who has recorded the statements of the parties and reported that the compromise has been effected voluntarily, without any pressure or coercion. In that view of the matter, the petition is allowed and the impugned FIR, along with all consequential proceedings, is quashed by way of compounding/compromise.
