INDERJIT SINGH, J.

Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.308 dated 27.07.2015, registered at Police Station SGM Nagar, District Faridabad, under Sections 420, 465, 468, 471 and 406 of the Indian Penal Code.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and gone through the record.

From the record, I find that FIR, in the present case, has been registered on the statement of Rampal, who stated that the present petitioner and co-accused, Harender asked him to get the job for his son and other relatives in Railways by paying ₹5 lacs per candidate and ultimately, ₹30 lacs were given for six candidates. It is also mentioned in the FIR that candidates were called at Patna Hajipur for training and they resided in

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Patna for one month. After sometime, the candidates realized that this all is going under forgery.

Keeping in view the nature and gravity of the offence and in view of the fact that the present petitioner is required for custodial interrogation, I do not find it a fit case where the petitioner is entitled for the benefit of anticipatory bail.

Therefore, finding no merit in the present petition, the same is dismissed.
