This petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C seeking directions to respondents to investigate the FIR and submit the final report.

The petitioner had been asked to place on record the documents to show that she was residing at Gurgaon. There is no document to show that she was a tenant in Malibu Town, Gurgaon. An affidavit has been furnished by the petitioner, according to which, her husband is facing two cases. The copies of the same have not been placed on record.

The rent agreement (Annexure P-4) relates to a period, which is after filing of the present petition. The allegations pertain to an incident which took place in May, 2015. The complainant had alleged that she did not confide her husband but later she disclosed about the incident to her husband and the complaint was made on 29.06.2015. Admittedly, there is no MLR. The police has already registered the FIR. Even a representation has been given by the petitioner, therefore, no directions are required to be passed.

The petition is dismissed.
