The petitioners seek grant of regular bail in case FIR No.15,  
dated 10.1.2016, registered under Sections 302, 201, 120-B of the IPC, at  
Police Station Sadar Gohana, District Sonapat.

As per allegations, wife of the complainant had been  
pressurizing him to sell his property and live in her parental house, as  
was her mother and her brother, and because of those circumstances, they

started living separately. After about 2½ months, the mother-in-law of the complainant told him that her daughter had seen her sense and he should take her back. On that, the complainant brought back his wife but over there his wife killed his mother and tried to burn her, and when the complainant tried to save his mother, she caused injuries to him also. It is further mentioned in the FIR that this was got done at the behest of the petitioner and her son (mother-in-law and brother-in-law of the complainant) who are before this Court.

Counsel for the petitioners has argued that even as per the case of the complainant himself, the petitioners were not present when the incident took place, and the main accused (wife) is in custody. Both the petitioners have now been in custody since 9.3.2016 and 26.5.2016 respectively.

Learned DAG Haryana, on instructions from ASI Samunder Singh, has laid stress on that part of the FIR where the complainant has alleged that this thing was got done by the petitioners.

Be that as it may, without commenting upon the merits of the case, and keeping in view the period of custody already suffered by the petitioners, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of regular bail to the petitioners.

Bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

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Petition stands disposed of.
