Learned counsel for the complainant has vehemently opposed the application for grant of anticipatory bail. The allegations are that the petitioner had forcibly injected overdose of the drug. This Court had issued an ad-interim order on 21.9.2016 granting anticipatory bail. The offence is registered under Section 304 IPC. Looking to the fact that the deceased was addict to the drugs and the further fact that he has joined the investigation, since custody is not required, as stated by Learned Counsel for the State on instructions from the Investigating Officer, interim order dated 21.9.2016 is made absolute.
