Present petition is for grant of regular bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C. on behalf of the petitioner/accused in case FIR No.200 dated 13.07.2015, under Sections 148, 149, 323, 452, 506, IPC and (Sections 325, 427, 307, IPC added later on), registered with Police Station Badhra, District Bhiwani (**Annexure P-2**).

As per the allegations, the petitioner/accused-Naseeb along with five other co-accused/non-applicants entered the house of the complainant-Kamla and inflicted injuries on her son-Jai Parkash.

The petitioner is attributed a *Danda* blow on the left feet of Jai Parkash, which resulted into fracture.

The petitioner is stated to be in custody since 09.09.2015.

Learned State Counsel, assisted by ASI Om Parkash, submits that 07 out of 14 prosecution witnesses have since been examined. He further submits that next date is fixed for 16.02.2016 and further unable to refute the custody period.

Without commenting on the merits of the case, keeping in view the custody period and the facts as noticed above, this Court finds that petitioner/accused deserves the concession of regular bail and as such he is ordered to be released on bail to the satisfaction of CJM/Duty Magistrate concerned.
