Petitioner has preferred this petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C., seeking interim bail for 20 days for treatment of his mother, who is suffering from heart ailment, in case FIR No.154 dated 19.08.2015, registered at Police Station Babain District Kurukshetra, under Section(s) 302, 34 IPC and Section 27 of the Arms Act.

On 27.09.2016, this Court passed the following order:-

“The petitioner has preferred the instant petition for grant of interim bail for 20 days for treatment of his mother, who is suffering from heart ailment.

Learned counsel for the respondent No.2 has stated that the petitioner, in one year of his custody, got the benefit of

interim bail on three occasions and actually, there is nothing serious with the mother of the petitioner.

In view of above, I deem it appropriate to adjourn the instant petition for seven days to enable the petitioner to place on record latest medical report of his mother from Government hospital.

Adjourned to 04.10.2016.”

Today, learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner's mother was taken to Civil Hospital, Kurukshetra from where she has been referred to PGI. He has shown the original card of PGI to the learned State counsel as well as learned counsel for complainant.

In these circumstances, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the prayer of the petitioner and direct that the petitioner be released on interim bail for 10 days to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court.

Accordingly, the instant petition stands disposed of.
