The petitioner is alleged to have committed unnatural offence with the son of the complainant.

The allegations against the petitioner are, no doubt, very serious, but in view of the fact that all the material witnesses have been examined, there is no chance of tampering with the evidence and the petitioner being in custody w.e.f. 17.10.2014 and seven more witnesses remaining to be examined, he can be granted the concession of bail.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed. The

petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court subject to the conditions that the petitioner will not indulge in similar activities during pendency of the trial and will not make any attempt to directly or indirectly threaten or induce the witnesses, who are yet to be examined. In case of misuse of the liberty by the petitioner, it will be open to the complainant to approach this Court for the cancellation of bail of the petitioner.
