By virtue of instant petition preferred under Section 438 Cr.P.C., petitioner Ankush Bansal has sought pre-arrest feeling apprehension of his arrest in case FIR No. 137, dated August 07, 2016, under Sections 420, 406, 506 & 34 IPC, registered at Police Station City Sri Muktsar Sahib, during the pendency of trial.

At the time of issuance of notice of motion on September 21, 2016, following order was passed:

“Notice of motion for 26.10.2016.

In the meanwhile, in the event of arrest, petitioner shall be released on ad-interim anticipatory bail in FIR No.137 dated 07.08.2016, registered under Sections 420, 406, 506 and 34 of

Indian Penal Code, 1860, at Police Station City Shri Muktsar Sahib, District Muktsar Sahib, on furnishing of his bail bond amounting to Rs.10,000/- with one surety of like amount to the satisfaction of the arresting officer/investigation officer.”

On instructions from ASI Pritam Singh, Learned State counsel has submitted that in compliance of order dated September 21, 2016 petitioner has already joined the investigation before the trial Court and he is no more required for further interrogation.

Accordingly, order dated September 21, 2016 is made absolute and shall enure during the pendency of trial, otherwise, this case is also based upon documentary evidence.

However, petitioner shall abide by all the terms and conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
