The present petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.282 dated 04.09.2016, registered under Section 420 of the Indian Penal Code (for short 'the IPC'), at Police Station Tripuri, District Patiala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner(s) contends that the petitioner has joined the investigation in pursuance of the order dated 21.09.2016 passed by this Court. She is one of the co-sharers of the land in question. She has sold her part of share to the complainant in the year 2011. The co-sharer did not agree with the partition. Thereafter the petitioner offered to repay the entire sale consideration.

On the other hand, learned State counsel, on instructions, submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and she is not required for further custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 21.09.2016, is made absolute, subject to furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned.

The petition stands allowed.
