This is an application for cancellation of pre-arrest bail granted to respondent No. 2, Manjit Singh.

On the instructions of Inspector Mangal Singh, it has been informed that after conducting investigation in a case registered at the instance of petitioner, Rajinder Singh, Amandeep Singh and Pran Nath have been found to be innocent whereas Sandeep Singh, Pragat Singh and Manvir Singh are yet to be arrested and their arrest warrants have been obtained.

Manjit Singh respondent No. 2, who has been granted the concession of pre-arrest bail is not involved in any other case and has not misused the concession of pre-arrest bail granted vide impugned order.

I have carefully applied the parameters for cancellation of bail and I am of the opinion that the anticipatory bail granted to Manjit Singh respondent No. 2 cannot be cancelled merely on the ground that his co-accused could not be arrested and few co-accused named by the petitioner have been declared innocent. The liberty having not been misused, no ground is made out to cancel the bail order in favour of respondent No. 2.
