Report dated 15.02.2016 sent by learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Mohali has been received, whereby, after recording statements of petitioner Ravinder Kaur as well as of complainant Sangeeta Kumari it has been informed that the parties have effected a compromise voluntarily on their free will and accord without any pressure.

Keeping in view that it is a pure money dispute and that the parties have effected a compromise for the offences which are not of heinous nature which will go a long way to sort out the differences between them and in view of law laid down in **Gian Singh vs. State of Punjab and another 2012(4) RCR Criminal 543** and **Kulwinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and another 2007(3) RCR Criminal 1052**, FIR No.26 dated 30.03.2013 under Sections 406 IPC Police Station, Phase 11, Mohali and all other consequential proceedings

arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the present petitioner.

Petition stands disposed off.
