A close scrutiny of the file transpires that earlier, petitioner moved a petition bearing CRM-M-18195 of 2013 (O&M) under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking quashing of FIR No.229, dated 02.11.2006, under Sections 406 and 420 IPC, registered at Police Station Tanda, District Hoshiarpur (Annexure P-1) on the basis of compromise and since, the petitioner was absconding from the ld. trial court, he has already been declared proclaimed offender. After arguing for some time, the said petition was withdrawn vide order dated 29.05.2013.

2. Even subsequent thereto, another petition bearing CRM-M-23772-2014 was filed and that was withdrawn vide order dated 11.08.2014 (Annexure P-7). Then, third petition bearing CRM-M-28436-2014 was filed, which was also withdrawn vide order dated 25.08.2014 (Annexure P-8) and fourth one bearing CRM-M-42194-2015 was filed, which was disposed of with

the direction to the petitioner to surrender before the ld. trial court within a period of 10 days.

3. Here, it would be pertinent to mention that even the petitioner did not care to comply with the direction given to him vide order dated 15.12.2015 (Annexure -10) and subsequent thereto, the instant petition has been moved.

4. In view of the non-compliance of order as well as conduct of the petitioner in filing time and again the same petition, is suggestive of the fact that he is not cooperating. Otherwise also, petition is not maintainable.

5. Dismissed.
