The instant petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.28 dated 18.03.2016 for the offence under Sections 451, 354 registered at Police Station Sadar Abohar Tehsil Abohar, District Fazilka (Charges framed under Section 452, 354, 354-A IPC and Section 8 of POCSO Act).

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that after registration of FIR, the matter has been compromised between the parties and petition i.e. CRM-M-19141 of 2016 has been filed for quashing of the said FIR which is fixed for 21.11.2016. Learned counsel for the State has not disputed regarding this fact.

Keeping in view the above, no custodial interrogation is required in the matter and petitioner be released on regular bail subject to the satisfaction of Duty Magistrate/Illaq Magistrate, Fazilka.
