Report dated 10.12.2015 sent by learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Moga has been received, whereby, after recording statements of petitioners Kuldeep Singh alias Gurdeep Singh as well as of complainant Kamaljit Kaur it has been informed that the parties have effected a compromise voluntarily on their free will and accord without any pressure.

Keeping in view that it is a pure civil dispute over land and that the parties have effected a compromise which will go a long way to sort out the differences between them and in view of law laid down in **Gian Singh vs. State of Punjab and another 2012(4) RCR Criminal 543** and **Kulwinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and another 2007(3) RCR Criminal 1052**, FIR No.65 dated 5.7.2012 under Sections 420,406,465,467,468,471,175, 120B IPC, Police Station, Mehna, and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom are

hereby quashed qua the present petitioner.

Petition stands disposed off.
