JASPAL SINGH, J.

This petition has been preferred under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for quashing of FIR No. 147, dated 01.08.2012, under Sections 420 and 167 IPC, registered at Police Station City Batala, District Gurdaspur (Annexure P-1) along with all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise (Annexure P-2).

2. In compliance of order dated September 24, 2015, report of Id. Judicial Magistrate has been received, in which, it has been categorically observed that matter has been compromised between the parties voluntarily without any threat, coercion or undue influence

and now complainant-respondent No.2 has no any grudge against the petitioners. Even otherwise, matter involved is personal in nature, which has been amicably put at rest.

3. In view of the above I am of the considered opinion that continuation of criminal proceedings between the parties would be an abuse of the process of law and the present compromise is for their benefit and will bring peace and harmony between them.

4. Consequently, instant petition stands allowed and FIR No. 147, dated 01.08.2012, under Sections 420 and 167 IPC, registered at Police Station City Batala, District Gurdaspur and all other subsequent proceedings arising therefrom are quashed qua the petitioners.
