By filing the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner has sought anticipatory bail in case FIR No.81, dated 22.04.2015, registered under Sections 420 read with Section 120-B of the Indian Penal Code (for short 'IPC'), at Police Station City-I, Abohar.

ASI Munshi Ram, present in the Court states that the parties have entered into compromise. A photocopy of the compromise is taken on record as Mark 'A'. He further states that the cancellation report has been filed in the matter. The compromise deed is also on record as Annexure P-2.

In view of the compromise reached between the parties, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 01.02.2016, is made absolute, subject to the conditions contained in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands allowed.
