The petitioners, who were on bail during the trial of the case did not put in appearance before the trial Court on 24.8.2016, as, according to them, they had wrongly noted the next date of hearing as 30.8.2016. For that reason, the trial Court cancelled their bail bonds and summoned them through non-bailable warrants of arrest.

While issuing notice, this Court had directed the petitioners to surrender before the trial Court on or before 30.9.2016 and in the event of their doing so, they were to be admitted to *ad interim* bail by the said Court.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners have surrendered before the trial Court on 30.9.2016 and admitted to *ad interim* bail.

After obtaining instructions from Head Constable

Shamsher Singh, learned State counsel has confirmed the
aforementioned fact.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties, the
petition is disposed of by making the order dated 24.9.2016
passed by this Court absolute subject to the petitioners furnishing
fresh bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
