INDERJIT SINGH, J.

Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.102 dated 08.06.2016, registered at Police Station Sadar Ludhiana, District Ludhiana City, under Sections 323, 324, 341, 426, 452, 148 and 149 IPC and Section 326 IPC (added later on).

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and perused the record.

As per the prosecution version, FIR, in the present case, has been registered on the statement of Tarsem Sharma. The present petitioner has been named in the FIR. He was stated to be armed with iron '*dah*'. He gave injuries on the middle of head of the complainant with iron '*dah*'.

Keeping in view the nature and gravity of the offence and in view of the facts that the petitioner has been named in the FIR; he was armed with deadly weapon i.e. iron '*dah*' and he caused injuries on the vital

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part of body i.e. head of the complainant and that the petitioner is required for custodial interrogation as weapon is yet to be recovered from him, I do not find it a fit case where the petitioner is entitled for the benefit of anticipatory bail.

Therefore, finding no merit in the present petition, the same is dismissed.
