This petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure is for issuance of direction to the official respondents to register an FIR against private respondent Nos.7 to 12 and take action against them in accordance with law.

Marriage of the petitioner was solemnized with Arvind Kumar-respondent No.7 on 22.02.2015. On account of some misunderstandings, the couple could not pull on together. Now the petitioner is residing with her parents at Chandigarh. As per petitioner, respondent Nos. 7 to 12 had visited her parental house and forced her to go with them. On her refusal, respondent No.7 gave her beatings in front of her parents and threatened to kill her. They also harassed her by visiting the school where she is teaching. With regard to her grievance, she made a representation dated 06.09.2016 (Annexure P-2) to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Chandigarh-respondent No.3, but no action has been taken thereon till date.

At this stage, this petition is disposed of by giving direction to the

Senior Superintendent of Police, Chandigarh-respondent No.3, to look into

the representation dated 06.09.2016 (Annexure P-2) and take appropriate action in accordance with law.
