JASPAL SINGH, J.

Instant petition has been preferred under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking quashing of cross case rapat No. 14 in FIR No.22 of 2011, dated 16.03.2011, under Sections 325, 324, 323, 148 and 149 IPC, Police Station Kathu Nangal, along with all subsequent proceedings arising out of the same, on the basis of compromise.

2. In compliance of order dated September 22, 2016, report of learned Judicial Magistrate has been received, in which, it has been categorically observed that compromise has been effected between the parties and the same is genuine, voluntary and without any coercion or undue influence. Even otherwise, the matter involved is personal in nature,

which has been amicably put at rest. Compromise is the soul of justice,

which not only enhances the social amity, harmony and peace but also reduces friction and discord.

3. So, in view of above circumstances, I am of the considered opinion that continuation of criminal proceedings between the parties would be an abuse of the process of law and the present compromise is for their benefit and will bring peace and harmony between them.

4. Consequently, the instant petition stands allowed and cross case rapat No. 14 in FIR No.22 of 2011, dated 16.03.2011, under Sections 325, 324, 323, 148 and 149 IPC, Police Station Kathu Nangal, and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom are quashed qua the petitioners.
