The petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in case FIR No.158, dated 7.3.2015, registered under Sections 148, 149, 302, 342, 120-B of the IPC and Sections 25, 27, 54, 59 of the Arms Act, at Police Station Jhajjar.

Counsel for the petitioner has argued that the co-accused of

the petitioner who were also alleged to be the conspirators have been

granted regular bail, and the petitioner has now been in custody since 27.4.2015.

Learned DAG Haryana, as well as counsel for the complainant have accepted these factual assertions.

In these circumstances, without commenting upon the merits of the case, and keeping in view the period of custody already suffered by the petitioner, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Petition stands disposed of.
