This order will dispose of an application for bail in FIR No.7 dated 15.05.2014 under Sections 21, 29, 61, 85 of the NDPS Act registered at Police Station SSOC, Amritsar.

The allegation against the petitioner is that one Kuldeep Singh @ Heera who was confined in jail in connection with FIR No.106 of 2014, on production warrant and during interrogation made a disclosure statement that he indulged in smuggling of heroin along with other smugglers Jasbir Singh, Surjit Singh, Hargobind Singh, Kuldeep Singh @ Babu, Harbinder Singh, Jagjit Singh and Bohar Singh. He also got recovered six packets of heroin alleged to have been concealed by him. So far as the petitioner is concerned, he was also named by Kuldeep Singh and Raman Kumar that the petitioner was also a smuggler.

So far as recovery part is concerned, it is an admitted fact that till date no recovery has been effected from the petitioner in a case which was registered on 15.05.2014.

It is not out of place to observe here that the petitioner has been arrested in this case on 10.11.2015 after he had been granted concession of bail on 06.11.2015 by this Court in FIR No.12 dated 07.09.2014 registered at Police Station SSOC, Amritsar and FIR No.18 dated 29.12.2014 registered at same Police Station SSOC, Amritsar.

In view of abovesaid circumstances, the petitioner can be granted concession of bail.

Petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
