Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail on behalf of the petitioner-Varinder Kumar Bhatia in case FIR No.95 dated 29.06.2015, under Sections 420, 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, registered with Police Station Chhajli, Distt. Sangrur.

As per the allegations, the owners along with their agents and employees of the firm working under the name and style of M/s Live Trading India have induced innocent investors for depositing payments to the tune of Rs.100 crores with the allurements that they will get extremely high rate of interest on such deposits.

It was contended that the petitioner was engaged only to impart training to the employees of the said firm for conduct of online trading and as such was never engaged in any kind of allurements to the investors.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and even the challan stands presented.

Learned State Counsel, assisted by ASI Surjan Singh, the challan having been presented submits that the custodial interrogation of the petitioner is no longer required.

In view of the above, interim protection/pre-arrest bail granted by this Court, vide order dated 01.02.2016, is made absolute.
