The petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in case FIR No.118, dated 9.4.2016, registered under Sections 21, 22, 29, 61, 85 of the NDPS Act, at Police Station City Barnala.

Counsel for the petitioner has argued that the petitioner was not arrested from the spot and he has now been in custody since 4.6.2016. Another case is also pending against him but in that case he is on bail.

Kulwant Singh, has accepted these factual assertions.

In these circumstances, without commenting upon the merits of the case, and keeping in view the period of custody already suffered by the petitioner, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.
