For having been found in possession of 135 grams of intoxicating powder which one analysis was found to contain Alprazolam, the petitioner has been in custody with effect from 20.08.2015. He had been granted concession of interim bail for a period of one year awaiting the report. It has been informed that out of 12 prosecution witnesses 4 witnesses stand already examined.

In the interest of justice this petition is disposed of with a direction that the prosecution agency shall make endeavour to produce all the remaining witnesses within four months after the next date of hearing.

It is ordered that in case for any reason, the trial is not concluded within a period of five months from the next date of hearing, the trial Court shall release the petitioner on bail on his furnishing bail bond/surety bond to its satisfaction.
