The petitioner was some how declared proclaimed offender on 08.04.2013, having not been arrested. Now he has been in custody w.e.f. 20.08.2014. Total 11 prosecution witnesses out of 21 have been examined. Since the petitioner was not apprehended along with the poppy husk, it will certainly be a debatable issue whether he was actually in possession of the poppy husk recovered from the car in his absence.

Without expression of any opinion on merits, taking into consideration the period of detention, the petitioner can be granted the concession of bail.

Petition is allowed. It is ordered that the petitioner will be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court subject to the condition that he will not indulge in any other similar activity during the pendency of the trial.
