KULDIP SINGH, J (ORAL)

The prayer in this present petition filed under Section 482 of Cr. P.C is for quashing of FIR No. 257 dated 23.08.2015 registered under Sections 353, 186, 295, 382, 511, 506, 148, 149 of IPC at Police Station Patti, District Tarn Taran alongwith all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise.

Report of the learned Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Patti, has been received wherein it has been reported that the statements of the both the complainants namely Bikramjit Singh and Lakhbir Singh and accused namely Jugraj Singh have been recorded and compromise has been effected between the parties. It is further reported that the said

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compromise is voluntary and is without any coercion, pressure or undue influence.

In this case the complainant is a Bus Driver. The allegation was of obstructing him from performing his duties.

Since, the parties have amicably settled their dispute, therefore, FIR No. 257 dated 23.08.2015 registered under Sections 353, 186, 295, 382, 511, 506, 148, 149 of IPC at Police Station Patti, District Tarn Taran qua the petitioner-Jugraj Singh stands quashed alongwith all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of the compromise.

In view of the above, the present petition stands allowed.
