JASPAL SINGH, J.

This petition has been preferred under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for quashing of FIR No. 34, dated 20.03.2009, under Sections 341, 323, 325 and 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Sultanwind, Amritsar City (Annexure P-1) on the basis of compromise.

2. In compliance of order dated September 28, 2015, report of Id. Judicial Magistrate has been received, in which, it has been categorically observed that the parties have made an amicable settlement and have recorded their statements without any fear or

pressure. Even otherwise, matter involved is personal in nature, which has been amicably put at rest.

3. In view of the above I am of the considered opinion that continuation of criminal proceedings between the parties would be an abuse of the process of law and the present compromise is for their benefit and will bring peace and harmony between them.

4. Consequently, instant petition stands allowed and FIR No. 34, dated 20.03.2009, under Sections 341, 323, 325 and 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Sultanwind, Amritsar City and all other subsequent proceedings arising therefrom are quashed qua the petitioners.
