The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.92 dated 03.10.2015 under Sections 324, 326 and 34 IPC registered at Police Station Majitha, District Amritsar.

Counsel for the petitioner has been heard.

This is a case whereby the direct and overt act of the present petitioner having armed with a datar and having inflicted a datar blow on the forehead of the complainant/injured Nirmal Singh is attributed. Precisely such injury has been declared to be grievous in nature and thereby attracting offence under Section 326 IPC.

Under such circumstances, this Court does not find any infirmity in the order dated 14.1.2016, passed by the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Amritsar declining the concession of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner.

Petition, accordingly, is dismissed.
