A.B. Chaudhari, J. (Oral):

Heard learned Counsel for the rival parties. In FIR No.61 dated 1.4.2016, under Sections 323, 324, 452, IPC, PS City Tarn Taran, District Tarn Taran, the petitioner is being prosecuted. The parties have now arrived at a compromise which is on record as Annexure P-2. This Court had directed recording of statements of the parties by order dated 22.9.2016. Now there is a report from Chief Judicial Magistrate, Tarn Taran that the statements have been recorded and compromise has been found to be genuine. Looking to the nature of the offences, I am inclined to allow compounding/compromise. Hence, petition is allowed. FIR in question, along with all consequential proceedings, is quashed by way of compounding/compromise.
