Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.65 dated 16.06.2016, registered at Police Station Bhogpur, District Jalandhar, under Sections 406, 420 and 170 of the Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion was issued. Learned State counsel put in appearance on behalf of the respondent-State and the complainant also appeared through his counsel. They contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner; learned State counsel as well as learned counsel for the complainant and have gone through the record.

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From the record, I find that as per the FIR, the present petitioner, Manjinder Kaur and her husband, Dharminder Singh cheated the people. The allegation against the present petitioner is that she proclaimed herself to be an Inspector in the Punjab Police and took money for recruitment in the Punjab Police.

The petitioner has been in custody since 16.06.2016. She is not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as she is in judicial custody. The trial of the case will take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail subject to her furnishing personal bonds in the sum of ₹50,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
