Through the present petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C., quashing of DDR No.26, dated 05.06.2016, under Sections 323, 324, 148, 149 IPC (Section 326 IPC added later on) (Annexure P-1) in FIR No.89, dated 05.06.2016, under Sections 323, 324, 34 IPC (Section 326 added later on), registered at Police Station Bagha Purana, District Moga) and all consequential proceedings arising out of the aforesaid DDR, on the basis of compromise (Annexure P-3) is sought for.

While issuing notice of motion on 26.09.2016, this Court had directed the parties to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate on 05.10.2016 to get their statements recorded. The Illaqa Magistrate was directed to send the report to this Court whether the compromise, if any, has been arrived at between the parties voluntarily.

As directed, the report of the Illaqa Magistrate dated 17.10.2016 has been received wherein it has been stated that the statements

of the parties had been recorded, which clearly shows that a genuine compromise has been entered into between them.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and DDR No.26, dated 05.06.2016, under Sections 323, 324, 326, 148, 149 IPC (Annexure P-1) in FIR No.89, dated 05.06.2016, under Sections 323, 324, 326, 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Bagha Purana, District Moga and all consequential proceedings arising out of the aforesaid DDR, are ordered to be quashed.
