This is a petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking quashing of FIR No.203 dated 17.12.2014, under section 66-A of Information Technology Act, 2000 and Section 3 of Scheduled Caste & Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocity) Act, 1989, registered at Police Station Nihal Singh Wala, District Moga.

Learned State counsel submits that petitioner No.2 has committed suicide and FIR No.21 dated 8.2.2015 under section 306 IPC has been registered against respondent No.1 at Police Station Nihal Singh Wala, on statement of wife of petitioner No.2. He submits that investigation in instant case shall be completed and final report submitted before the court. According to him, no case is made out for quashing of the FIR in view of the development that has taken place.

I find substance in plea of the State counsel. There is no ground for interference in inherent jurisdiction of this court.

Dismissed.
