This is a petition for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in case FIR No.69 dated 06.09.2015 registered under Sections 420/465/467/468/471/120-B IPC at P.S.City 2 Mansa, District Mansa.

On 23.09.2016 the following order was passed :-

“Notice of motion returnable for 03.11.2016.

Meanwhile, in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on ad-interim anticipatory bail in FIR No.69 dated 06.09.2015, registered under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 & 120-B IPC, at Police Station City 2 Mansa, District Mansa, on furnishing of bail bonds amounting to Rs.10,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer.”

Learned Additional Advocate General, on instructions from ASI Raj Singh accepts the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no more required for custodial interrogation.

In these circumstances, I do not deem it appropriate to deny anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Resultantly, the petition is allowed. The interim order dated 23.09.2016 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
