JASPAL SINGH, J.(ORAL)

By virtue of the instant petition preferred under Section 439 of Code of Criminal Procedure, petitioners have sought the concession of bail, pending trial, in case bearing FIR No.225 dated 08.12.2013, under Sections 302, 201, 34 of Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Samrala, District Ludhiana.

Undoubtedly, petitioners are languishing in jail since 8th January, 2014, the date they were arrested. No doubt, after completion of the investigation, report under Section 173(2) Cr.P.C. was presented against the accused and charge was framed but all the three material witnesses have not supported the case of the prosecution. No doubt, as per the version of learned State counsel, three witnesses are remained to be examined but they are formal witnesses.

In view of the facts referred to above but without expressing any opinion on merits of the case, petition is allowed and petitioners are

ordered to be released on bail on their furnishing requisite bail bonds as per the satisfaction of concerned ld. trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
