JITENDRA CHAUHAN, J. (Oral)

This petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.217 dated 28.10.2005 registered under Sections 307, 323, 324, 336, 506 and 148 read with Section 149 of the Indian Penal Code (in short 'IPC') and Sections 25, and 27 of Arms Act at Police Station Phillaur, Jalandhar.

It is contended that initially FIR was registered under Sections 307, 323 and 148 read with Section 149 of IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act and subsequently Section 307 IPC was deleted. Co-accused who suffered trial stand acquitted during the pendency of the present petition. Compromise (Exhibit P-1) has been effected between the parties . He further contends that petitioner is not involved in any other FIR.

Notice of motion.

At the asking of the Court, Mr. Saurabh Mohunta, DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State. A complete copy of the paper book has been furnished to the learned State counsel, in the

Court.

Though the Court would hesitate to intervene in the matter to rescue the petitioner who has misused the bail, however, considering the fact that the similarly placed co-accused has been given similar benefit by this Court vide order dated 29.01.2016 and the fact that co-accused stand acquitted, it is ordered that in case the petitioner surrenders within three weeks from today, he be admitted to bail on furnishing fresh bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court subject to payment of Rs.50,000/-s as costs to the State towards costs of litigation.
