This petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.17 dated 20.03.2016, registered under Sections 307/392/427/506/148/149 IPC and Sections 25/27 of Arms Act, at Police Station Rure Ke Kalan, District Barnala.

This is a case where FIR under Section 307 IPC has been lodged against both the parties for having caused gun shot injuries.

After arguing for some time, the learned counsel for the petitioner states that he does not wish to press this petition on merits but liberty may be granted to the petitioner to surrender before the trial Court and move an application for regular bail and a direction may be issued to the Court to decide the said application expeditiously.

I find this to be a fair request. Let the petitioner surrender before the Court on 12.10.2016 and move an application for regular bail which shall be decided expeditiously by the Court but in any case on or before 15.10.2016.

Petition stands dismissed as having been not pressed.

A copy of this order be given *dasti* to learned counsel for the petitioner on payment of usual charges.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
