By filing the present petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner has sought regular bail in case FIR No.268, dated 07.09.2012, registered under Sections 381, 201 read with Section 34 IPC, at Police Station Zirakpur, District SAS Nagar, Mohali.

On 29.10.2015, this Court had passed the following order:-

“Pursuant to order dated 13.10.2015, Mr.Gurpreet Singh Bhullar, Senior Superintendent of Police, Mohali is present in court. Learned State counsel seeks to place on record his affidavit. Prayer is accepted. Affidavit is taken on record. He has assured the court that investigating officer will remain present in court well in time to instruct the State counsel. According to affidavit, two Pairvi Officers have also been appointed to pursue

the matters.

Petitioner is in custody since 17.7.2015. Investigation qua him is complete. He is directed to be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Mohali during the pendency of this petition.

Personal appearance of the officer is exempted till further orders.

Adjourned to 14.12.2015. ”

The learned State counsel, on instructions informs that the application moved before the trial Court for discharge of the petitioner is still pending consideration.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 29.10.2015 shall remain operative during the pendency of trial on furnishing of fresh bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

The petition stands allowed.
