The petitioner seeks the concession of regular bail in a case registered at the instance of the complainant, namely Manoj Kumar Sharma, alleging that the complainant had purchased land and was managing the same without appointing any attorney. In July, 2014, on checking of the revenue records, he found that some part of his land had been sold by impersonation. The petitioner is alleged to have identified an impostor as Mata Parshad before the Sub Registrar. The land was sold vide two sale deeds dated 27.04.2016 and 26.06.2014. The co-accused of the petitioner, namely Dhian Singh, who had identified the impostor as Mata Prashad, has been granted the concession of bail by this Court

(Annexure P-5, dated 08.10.2015).

The challan has already been presented. The impersonator, namely Amarbir Singh, is stated to be in the custody.

The petitioner, in the abovesaid circumstances, can be granted the concession of bail.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
